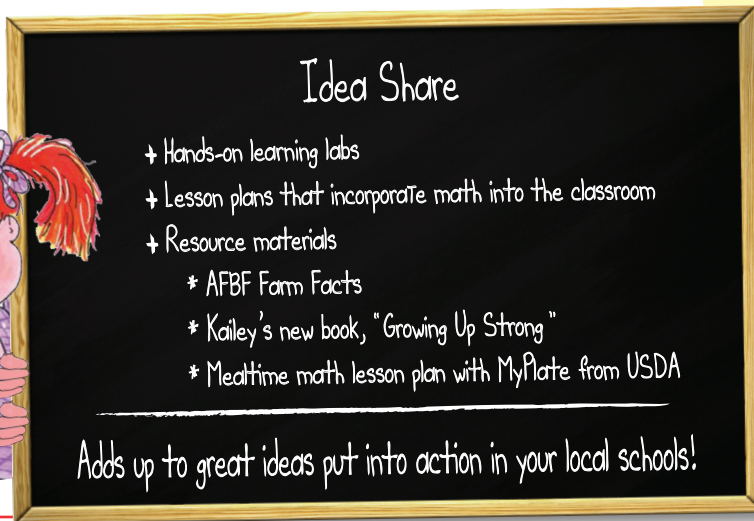


2012 Be Ag-Wise Workshops
