

Grow Your Own Pizza Sauce

You'll need:

- 1- 48" window box with holes drilled in bottom for drainage
- 1 - Tomato Plant
- 1 - Basil Plant
- 2 - Oregano Plants
- 1 - Garlic Bulb
- 1 - Onion Set
- 1 - Bell Pepper Plant
- Bark Mulch
- Enough soil to fill box $\frac{3}{4}$ full



Fill window box $\frac{3}{4}$ full with soil. Dig holes for plants, according to the order listed above. Place plants in holes and cover with soil. Add bark mulch, leaving about 1" from top of window box. Place window box in sunny outdoor area and water thoroughly. Check water needs daily. When the top inch of soil is dry, water thoroughly.
