- **Provide scholarships to young people who intend to make agriculture their life's work**

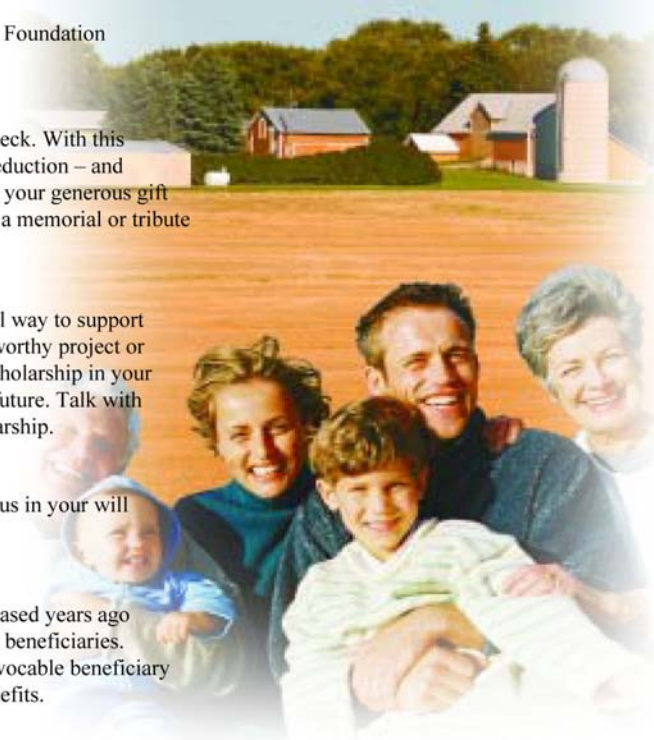
## How you can strengthen the Foundation
