

KANSAS FARM BUREAU REWARD PROGRAM

**Your county Farm Bureau, in cooperation with Kansas Farm Bureau,
provides this program as one of the many benefits you receive as a member!**



Guidelines:

- KFB will pay a reward of \$1,000 to the person who furnishes information that leads to the arrest and conviction of a person(s) for committing theft, arson, or vandalism on the Kansas premises of a Farm Bureau member who has a Farm Bureau reward sign posted in a conspicuous place on his/her premises.
- Member is an individual, partnership or corporation who is a member in good standing of a Kansas county Farm Bureau at the time the crime is committed and at the time the claim is submitted. Member in good standing shall mean that Farm Bureau membership is paid on or before the anniversary date each year to sustain this uninterrupted service.
- Premises shall include only that property in which the member has a direct financial interest.
- Conviction shall mean final conviction of a felony in Kansas. Conviction shall mean an adjudication, by a court of competent jurisdiction, of a minor offender as being a delinquent child for reason of having committed an act that would have resulted in a felony conviction had the offender been and adult. The reward does not apply for conviction of a misdemeanor. However, a substitute reward of \$500 will be paid in those cases of theft, arson or vandalism where the original complaint and arrest was for that of a felony and is subsequently amended to that of a misdemeanor, and conviction results; or where the original complaint and arrest was for that of a felony and court-approved diversion agreement is entered into between the prosecutor and the defendant; or a pre-filing diversion agreement is entered into between the prosecutor and the defendant.
- Law enforcement officers are not eligible for the reward.
- When any theft, arson, or vandalism occurs on a member's property, he/she shall give immediate notice to his/her county or local law enforcement agency and his/her county Farm Bureau, and he/she shall assist and cooperate at all time in the investigation, collection and preservation of evidence relating to such occurrence.
- The liability of Kansas Farm Bureau for a reward is limited as follows:
 - Only one reward, regardless of the acts committed, persons convicted, or sources of information provided, will be paid for conviction(s) which result from substantially the same occurrence or circumstances.
 - If more than one person furnishes information leading to the arrest and conviction of a person(s), the Kansas Farm Bureau Reward Committee shall determine the person entitled to the reward.
 - If Farm Bureau membership is in the name of a corporation or partnership, the premises covered shall include only that property owned by the corporation or partnership.
