Secondhand Smoke:

- ☹ Irritates the eyes, nose, throat and lungs of everyone exposed to it.
- ☹ Is responsible for the deaths of nearly 3,000 nonsmokers every year due to lung cancer.
- ☹ Contains over 4,000 chemical compounds that include at least 43 cancer-causing substances.
- ☹ Increases the chances that children will suffer from bronchitis, pneumonia, asthma and other lung diseases.
- ☹ Makes it more likely that children will develop middle-ear disease.
- ☹ Increases the number of asthma attacks and the severity of asthma.
- ☹ Has been linked to increases in Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS).
