Stresses the importance of hand signals when working around noisy farm machinery.

**FARM SAFETY FAMILY STYLE** 50:00

PART 1: **Kids Talk Farm Safety Stuff** - Discussion with kids about dangers they see on the farm. Ages 4-10.

PART 2: **Farm Safety, Family Style** - Candid conversations with farm families about safety concerns and the changing roles of farm wives and mothers.

PART 3: **Farm Safety, A Second Chance** - Individuals and families share how their lives have been affected by a farm injury or fatality. Ages 8 to adult.

PART 4: **Safety Net** - Targets middle school age youth. Includes a PTO demonstration, safety tips for ATVs and a special message by the country music group, Little Texas.

**FARM SAFETY FOR KIDS / KIDS TALK FARM SAFETY STUFF** 23:00

Farm Safety for Kids (16 min.) - This video covers many of the hazards by which farm children have been killed or maimed. Safety professionals and medical personnel point out some of the ways in which tragedy can be prevented.

Kids Talk Farm Safety Stuff (7 min.) - A fast paced discussion with kids about dangers they see on the farm. Appropriate for children ages 4 to 10.

An overview of Farm Safety Day Camps in various locations. Includes interviews with those involved in staging the programs and clips of actual sessions sponsored.
