Travel Tips for Washington D.C

Transportation in DC

- When arriving at Reagan National Airport, there will be plenty of cabs to take you to the hotel (about 5 miles away and cab fare runs about \$15-20). There will also be plenty of cabs outside of our hotel if you need transportation.
- If you feel comfortable using the Metrorail, the Orange and Blue lines run from Reagan Airport into downtown DC. The nearest Metro stop to the Residence Hotel is the Federal Center Metro stop. Please refer to the Metro map that is attached with this packet.
