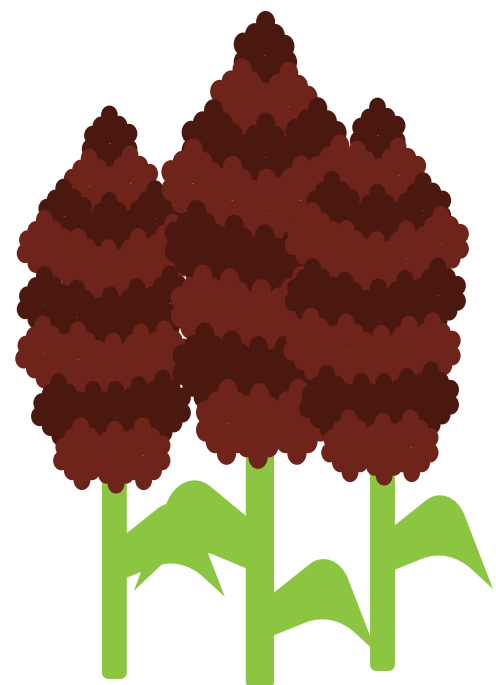


# sorghumfacts

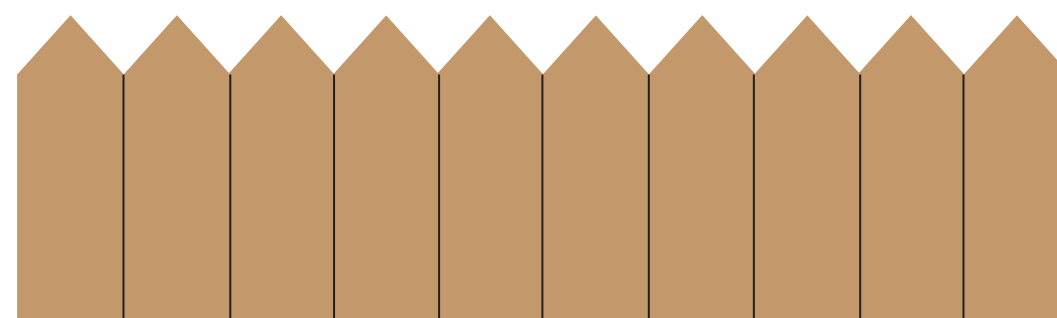
Sorghum is water efficient, requiring only **6 inches of total water** to produce the first bushel of grain.
