Travel Tips for Washington D.C

Transportation in DC

- When arriving at Reagan National Airport (DCA), there will be plenty of cabs or Ubers to take you to the hotel (about 5 miles away and cab fare runs about \$15-20). There will also be cabs outside of our hotel if you need transportation.
- If you feel comfortable using the Metrorail, the Blue line runs from Reagan National Airport into
 downtown DC. The nearest Metro stop to the Residence Inn Hotel is the Federal Center SW
 Metro stop (with access to the Blue, Orange and Silver lines). Please refer to the Metro map that is
 attached with this packet.

- Registration will be held by KFB staff, near the hotel entrance, followed by dinner with your district director. **Please make sure to get registered and join us for a brief LEADs 101**.
