KEY COMPONENTS

- **Intro Session** - bond with other fellows, connect with Farm Bureau leaders and staff and establish a strong foundation for the program.
- **FB Experiences** - take part in a county board meeting, district policy issue meeting, the state YF&R Leaders Conference and a capstone Washington D.C. experience to see how Farm Bureau functions, from grassroots decisions to advocacy on Capitol Hill.
- **Mentor Match** - meet monthly, online or in person, with a mentor picked specifically for you based on your career interests.
- **Learning Lab** - monthly virtual classroom sessions or assignments that enhance your experience and prepare you for your future.
- **Cohort Project** - work with your peers to leave your mark on Farm Bureau.
