Iudging

- The entry form and application of each state entry will be coded upon receipt by KFB. The applicant's name will not be revealed to the judges until judging is completed.
- Judging is based on the application sent to KFB and an interview during the State YF&R Conference of the given year.
- A panel of qualified judges will select the state winner.
- Interviews will be up to 20 minutes in length and are intended to evaluate the competitor's command of the farm/ranch business and financials, familiarity of the contents of the application and appreciation for the value of Farm Bureau (see rubric). In addition to the 5 points allocated for the interview, judges may alter scores from other sections based on what they learn during the interview.
- During the interview process, only the named applicant(s) on the entry form is permitted into the interview.
