

Farm Facts



Farmers receive only <u>**16 cents</u>** out of every dollar spent on food. In 1980, farmers received <u>**31 cents.**</u></u>

A single American farmer feeds 155 people.



Conservation tillage reduces soil loss while using less energy. The acreage using this practice has increased 46% since 1982.
