WRITE A LETTER TO A DAIRY FARMER

After reading Milk Comes From a Cow? you are probably thinking about all of your favorite dairy products like milk, ice cream, cheese, butter, yogurt, etc. You might also be thinking about the farmer who helped get those yummy treats to your plate.

If you would like to let a Kansas dairy farmer know how thankful you are, what better way than to write them a letter? Today, let's learn how to write a thank you letter to thank our dairy farmer friends for providing us with safe, healthy food!

Your letter needs three things: a greeting, the body, and a closing.

- The greeting is who the letter is written to. In this case write Dear Kansas Dairy Farmer.
- The second part of a letter is the body, which is the part of the letter where you thank the dairy farmer. Explain why you are thankful.
- The third part is the closing, which is where you write 'Sincerely,' and then sign your name so that the person receiving the letter knows who is thanking them.
- Contact your local Farm Bureau office to give your letter to a dairy farmer.
- If you wrote to a dairy farmer you know, be sure to send the letter directly to that farmer.
- Ask an adult to help you address the envelope and put a stamp on it.
